

TYM launches new tractor range

South Korean tractor manufacturer, TYM Tractors, has launched their latest model range. The new TYM T413 HST compact tractor was showcased at a recent international event along with the new T75 and T95 utility tractors. In addition, the re-release of the T273 tractor was presented with a very competitive price point to tempt new buyers.

Inlon Pty Ltd invited a group of farm machinery dealers to join them for the TYM tractor launch in South Korea. The group visited TYM's 40,000 m² manufacturing facility in Iksan city, the front-end loader and mid-mount mower factory in Noseong, South Chungcheong, and the state-of-the-art R&D centre. Test drives and inspections left them in no doubt that these South Korean made, high quality tractors will be a popular addition to the range in Australia.

Gary Surman, Inlon's Sales & Marketing Manager, describes the new models. 'The TYM T413 HST tractor, with its 38.4hp Japanese Yanmar diesel engine, is available in both ROPS (Roll Over Protection Frame) and Air-conditioned Cabin models. In fact, the TYM T413 brings to the Australian market the best price sub 40hp 4wd compact tractor available with an Air-conditioned Cabin—a perfect upgrade for those long hot days. Quality features include 3 range HST transmission, 1200 kg linkage lift capacity, a flat operators platform, level-lift quick-hitch loader and 4-in-1 bucket, and an integrated loader joystick with 3rd function. At the factory visit, we compared T413 specifications against all the major brands. The dealers were impressed with how it stacked up and the value for money.'

Turning to the new TYM ROPS utility tractors, the T75 (75hp) and T95 (95hp) models, Surman talks about this market sector. 'Much of the basic ROPS utility tractor market is dominated by budget Indian and Chinese product. The dealers at the launch told us their customers are looking for good value tractors that will stand the test of time. TYM offers a competitively priced high quality product that is completely made in South Korea. The T75 and T95 come with 12 x 12 shuttle shift transmission and a flat operators platform. Optional level-lift Euro-hitch loader with 4-in-1 bucket available.'

Surman explains why the T273 tractor has returned with new pricing. 'The T273 compact tractor was the best-selling TYM tractor in Australia ever, but it was recently overtaken by the T313 model because of the extra horsepower and features on the T313. However, the T273 has returned with a great new price point for a strictly limited stock promotion to show up its big brother and take back the mantle! The T273 and T313, with their Japanese Mitsubishi engine, are the strongest compact tractors on the market and come with side-by-side HST pedals and a level-lift quick-hitch loader with 4-in-1 bucket.'

Surman sums up the appeal of TYM tractors. 'The 3 year warranty plan on all TYM tractors gives peace of mind, and South Korean manufacturing is renowned on the world stage for its quality made and well-designed products, backed by heavy research and development investment. In fact, South Korea's capital investment in R&D is among the highest in the world as a percentage of GDP.
