If you've been using a ride-on mower, or moving soil and digging holes by hand, take a look at the new TYM T194 sub-compact tractor from Inlon – we think you'll like what you see. It has the horsepower and flexibility to handle a wide range of implements and tasks, including moving soil, digging holes, general landscaping and cutting grass. The T194 really is the ultimate power tool for rural properties.

Add accessories for even greater productivity, such as a front-end level lift loader, with a large 4in 1 bucket that's quick and simple to detach, or a mid-mounted mower cutting deck fitted with 3 blades to produce a smooth, even lawn finish.

It's hard to go past the performance of the legendary Japanese Yanmar engine, producing 19hp with its 993cc diesel engine.

It will produce plenty of grunt allowing you to complete all your tasks around the property. Choose from industrial or turf tyres to suit your needs.

With the heavy build and quality, you would expect from South Korean manufacturer TYM, backed by a three year warranty plan, this tractor weighs an impressive 650kg excluding attachments. Most of its weight comes from the cast iron components rather than die-cast aluminium, delivering weight to the transmission and driveline where you need it most.

Unlike a ride-on mower, the T194 tractor is fitted with an approved roll over protective structure (ROPS), which folds away for space-saving storage into a small shed. Ergonomically, access on and off the tractor is easy from both sides and the flat wide operator's area makes for a comfortable ride. Driver comfort is also enhanced with the Yanmar diesel engine producing its 19hp at lower engine revs. The tractor's hydrostatic transmission offers simple variable forward and reverse drive via twos pedals.
